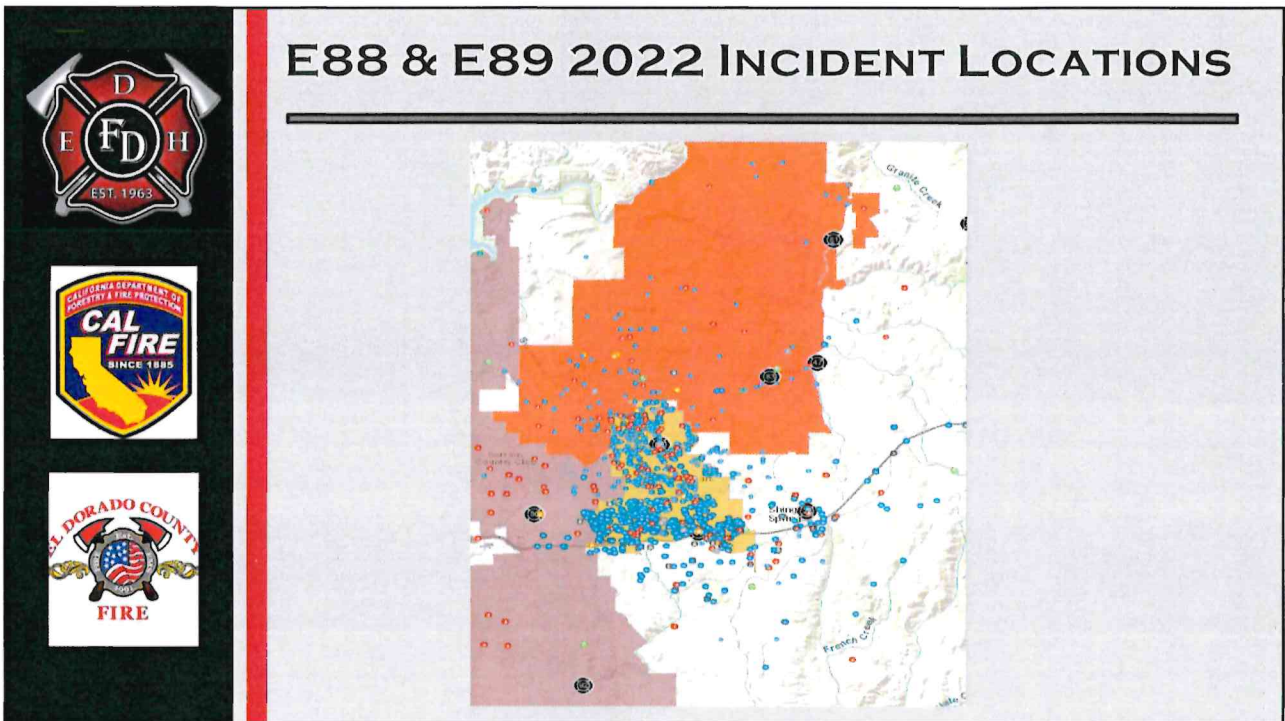
E88 2022 INCIDENT LOCATIONS



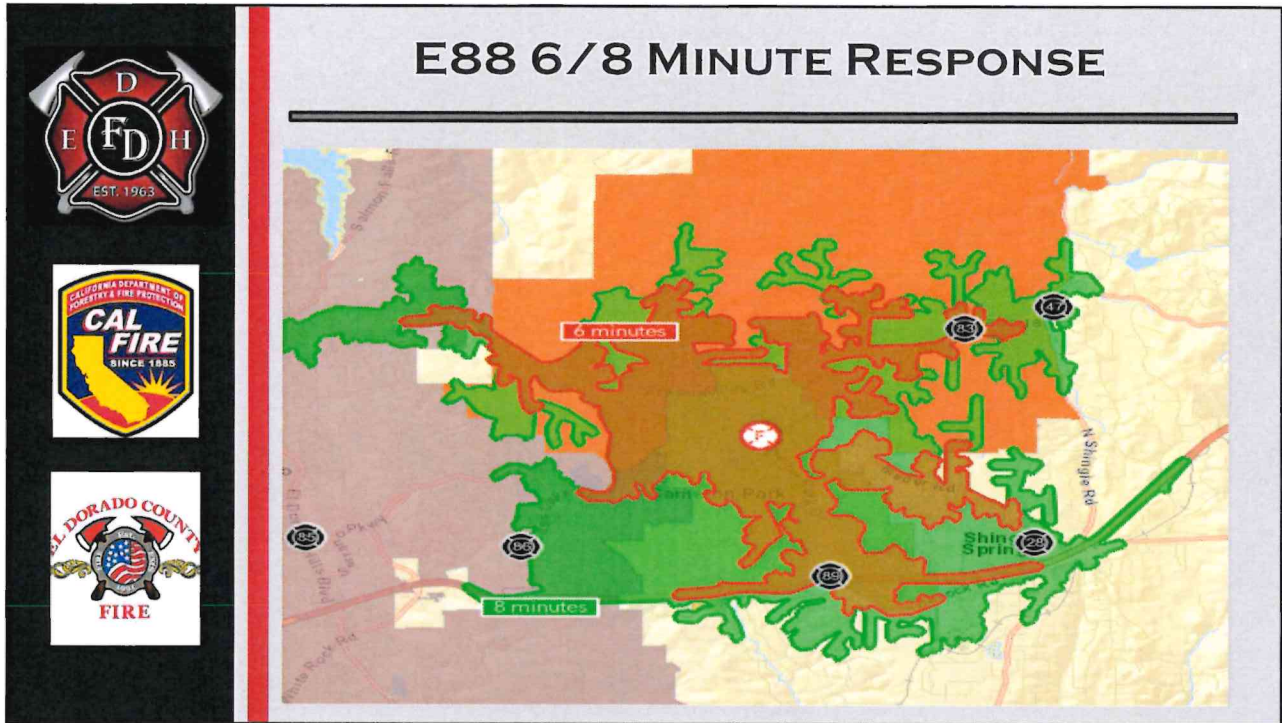

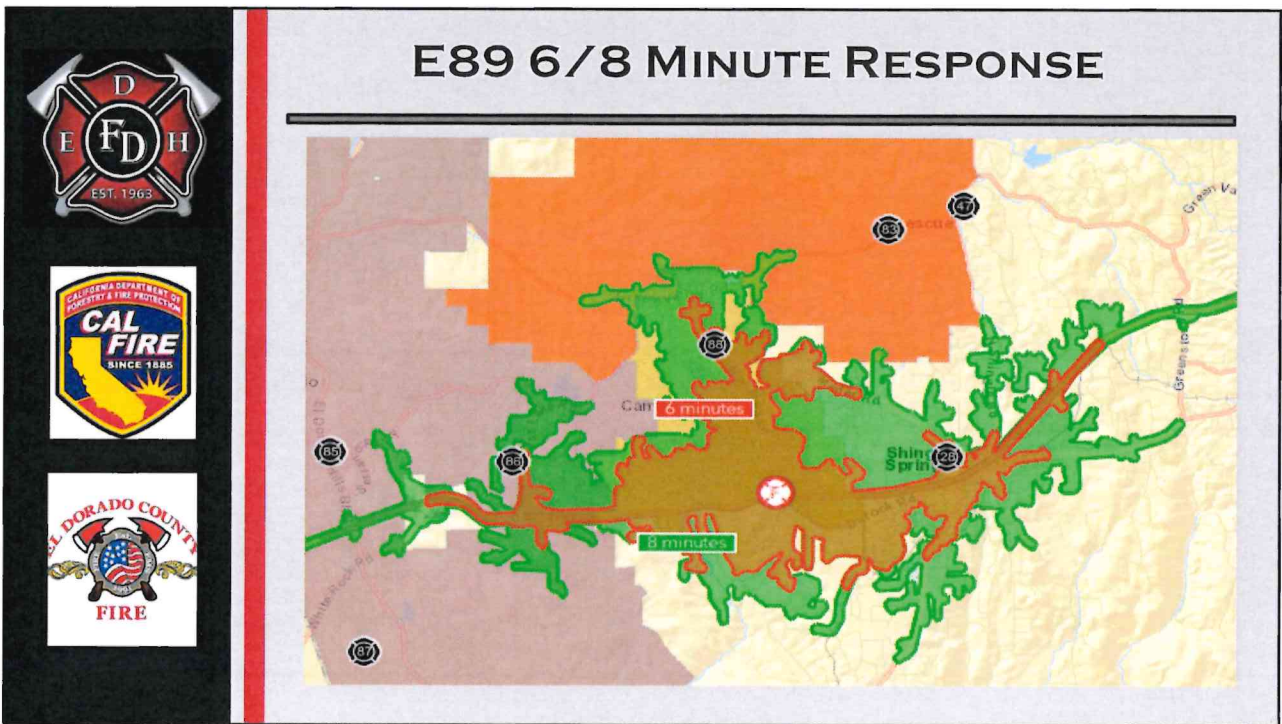
